I bequeath to Girls Inc. of Greater Santa Barbara, a California State, not-for-profit corporation located at 531 East Ortega Street, Santa Barbara, CA, 93103, the sum of _____ (\$) DOLLARS [or] a _____ percent (_____ %) of my [residuary] estate to be used for its general charitable purposes (or insert specific designation/purpose here).
