- Keeping accurate records of attendance
- Developing and evaluating appropriate progressions for the gymnasts' skill level
- Being a mentor and leader setting a positive example and role model for the gymnasts
- Encouraging, challenging, and supporting children as they experience gymnastics
- Participating in staff trainings, meetings, and events
- Maintaining organization and cleanliness of the gym facility, equipment, resources, and supplies
- Interacting with families in a positive and welcoming way
- Adapting and abiding to the changing COVID 19 policies and procedures

Minimum Requirements:
