Through evidence-based programs, led by trained mentoring professionals, Girls Inc. girls learn to be confident and embrace positive decision-making to take charge of their health and well-being, and achieve academic, personal, and career goals.

Girls Inc. of Greater Santa Barbara endeavors to foster an organizational culture that reflects the virtues of strong, smart, and bold through our core values of empowerment, inclusivity, respect, professionalism, and gender justice.

Facilitator Essential Job Functions Include:

- Creating, preparing for, and facilitating daily hands-on and intentional activities for a group of 14 girls, within our Core Essential Services (Healthy Living, Academic Enrichment and Support, and Life Skills)
- Content areas can include: art, STEM, cooking, movement, outdoor adventures, financial literacy, social emotional learning, girls and women in history, etc.
- Ensuring girls safety, both physically and emotionally, though active supervision while they
 participate in structured program activities, offsite field trips, lunch and snack time and
 informal program time
- Abide and adhere to the safety requirements and procedures of our operations
- Keeping accurate records of attendance
- Evaluating programs for effectiveness of intended outcomes
- Being a mentor and leader setting a positive example and role model for the girls
- Participating in staff trainings, meetings, and events
- Maintaining organization and cleanliness of programming areas, resources, and supplies
- Creating a pro-girl environment
- Interacting with families in a positive and welcoming way

Minimum Requirements:

- 12 college level units in any of the following courses: early childhood education, sociology, psychology, art, music, dance, drama, recreation

- Vaccinations as required by State Law for licensed child care facilities (TB, Pertussis and Measles Immunizations, Flu vaccine recommended-but optional).
